UOCAVA Election Notice Update

USC § 20A-16-502(1)

The Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) serves American Citizens that (1) reside overseas OR (2) currently serve in the military (including spouses/eligible dependents) AND currently reside outside of Utah.

If you meet these qualifications, you may elect to receive a ballot mailed to your mailing address of record or via email. You may also vote using a federal write-in absentee ballot (FWAB).

Ballots requested through the Federal Post Card Application are sent by mail or through the electronic Enhanced Voting service no later than 45 days before each election.

Overseas and Military voters must return their by-mail or electronic ballot by the later of the following deadlines: (1) 8:00 p.m. Utah time on Election Day; or (2) 12:01 a.m. on Election Day in the time zone where the voter completes the ballot.

For more information on the use of the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), the Federal Voting Assistance Program (fvap.gov), and related deadlines, or the use of a Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB) if you do not receive your ballot in time, please contact the Grand County Clerk/Auditor's Office.

All counties in the State of Utah use an electronic ballot delivery method called Enhanced Voting. If you selected email or online voting on your FPCA, please watch for an email from Enhanced Voting / Enhanced Ballot.

How to Cast a Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB)

USC § 20A-16-502(2)(b))

1. Obtain the blank FWAB (Form SF186) from www.fvap.gov or any U.S. embassy or consulate.
2. Complete the FWAB “Voter Information” page completely and accurately. Sign and date.
3. On the FWAB Office/Ballot Measure grid, write the office titles exactly as shown on vote.utah.gov and then write the candidate’s name of your choice.
 - a. Visit vote.utah.gov for candidate information.
4. If a ballot proposition (or other item) is added, write its number (e.g., “Proposition1”) and then write “FOR” or “AGAINST.”
 - a. *Optional: You may add any federal, state, or county offices that appear on your Utah ballot on the “Addendum” area following the same format.*
5. Sign the voter declaration.
6. Return the FWAB to the Grand County Clerk/Auditor’s Office before 8pm MT on Election Day.
